A. Project Reports & Grants

Courtney and Mark finished the feedlot inspections for 2016; site visits and online reporting. Had a meeting with the Garry Johanson, ESO who mentioned there is still some interest in folks having hog operations set up in Norman County. Had a request for streambank repair, will work with the landowner on this. Lori and Courtney attended a meeting in Detroit Lakes on elink reporting.

B. Buffer Program

Mark drove around with the area hydrologist looking at 4 sites for buffers that folks have requested to be removed off the map. Working with our Board Conservationist on alternative practices. Folks have been calling or stopping in asking about the buffer program. Had a meeting with the Wild Rice Watershed and the ESO officer to talk about each agency's involvement with the buffer program. Courtney is working on a database for sending out letters to folks explaining the buffer program and the deadlines involved.

C. County Commissioner Meeting

Met with the county commissioners in December, presented our budget, asked for a \$1,000 increase from \$63,200 to \$64,200, it was approved. The commissioners also approved a \$22,750 increase to our office for the SWCD Capacity Grant. The state is matching these funds which will be used for erosion projects. Mark gave an update on the feedlot and WCA program, and updated the board on the buffer program.

D. Advertise for Pasture Bids

We will be advertising in the paper for 2 weeks requesting bids for the pasture. The bids will be opened at our February board meeting and acted upon. The board wants the contract to be for 2 years.
