We have 30 CSP applications so far, deadline is June 30th.

BWSR: Brett presented the board with a 75 years of service plaque for the office. Talked about the buffer program; SWCD makes the final decision for alternative practices. There will be enforcement dollars if the county decides to take this on, \$160,000 for this year and \$200,000 for next year. Capacity funding is approved for the coming biennium, BWSR is trying to get the legislators to move these dollars to BWSR's general fund.
