There are 20 applications for EQIP, mostly cover crops, high priority applications will be funded first. CSP signup ended on February 3rd. Working on CCRP and the CP38 Safe Program.

Watershed: Duane Erickson spoke on behalf of the watershed. An analysis on the Green Meadow Dam suggested the need for more permanent grass cover and less cropland. Looking at getting a \$500,000 grant to study the Moccasin Creek and the South Branch. One half of the property taxes collected by the watershed is given to the Red River Basin Board. The board approved increasing their donation to the SWCD's from \$100 to \$200 for the Envirothon.
