Watershed: Had a meeting yesterday; a board manager submitted her resignation as she is moving out of the area. Addressed a permit for 110 ft. of storage north of Gary, talked to the adjourning landowners for permission and still had to table the permit because of a 3 to 3 vote. Discussed another permit for an ag banking site for ditch plugs, approved the permit with a 200' setback from the property line.
